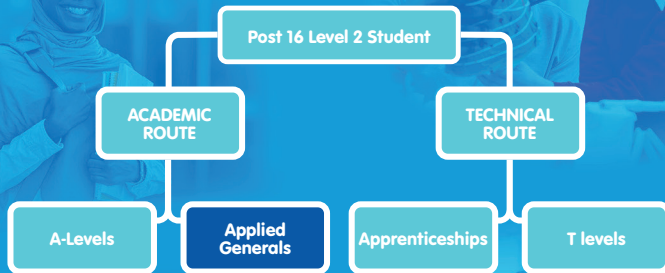

OPTIONS

After GCSEs there are lots of different options open to you. What suits you is quite likely to be different to some of your friends and will depend on what you want to do for a career in the future.



There are two main routes after school: academic and technical. The academic route includes qualifications like A levels and the International Baccalaureate. People doing this often want to spread the choice of subjects they study, and may be thinking about going onto university after A levels etc.

Technical and vocational qualifications, which include T levels, apprenticeships and BTECs, focus on the career you want, giving you skills, knowledge and practical experience to help springboard you into a job.

Additional support

Making the move from school to college can be scary and sometimes overwhelming. We work with students who need extra support to prepare them for college in a range of ways.

This includes reviewing what support has been provided in school, contacting young people directly, offering summer sessions and individual campus tours and orientation.

What are T levels

T levels are a new level 3 qualification for people under 19, that combine practical and classroom study in college with a meaningful industry placement, to put what you have learnt into practice.

They are equivalent to 3 A levels, and you can go onto university or higher education with them, or go straight into work.

What are Apprenticeships

An apprenticeship is a job with training. You'll spend 80% of your time in work and 20% doing off the job training. We offer apprenticeships from level 2 (the same level as GCSE through to higher – university – level). You get paid while you learn and gain real life skills in the work place.
